



A Differently-Abled Friendly Campus

Phoenixia University is committed to a campus where every student, regardless of ability, can learn, grow, and belong. Accessibility at PU spans our physical campus, our academic policies, and the support services available to students.

ACCESSIBILITY ACROSS CAMPUS

- Wheelchair ramps and elevators across campus buildings
- Accessible restrooms, parking, and tactile signage
- Accessible classrooms and lab furniture
- Accessible transportation options
- Priority and accessible housing options



Students with a documented disability or learning difference can request formal accommodations for exams and coursework. A request, along with medical documentation, is initiated through the Student Health Care Center, which coordinates with the Office of the Registrar. Eligible students receive an official Accommodation Notice shared with instructors – kept confidential throughout.

ACADEMIC ACCOMMODATIONS

- ADHD – extended time, reduced-distraction testing
- Learning differences (e.g. dyslexia) – extended time, alternative formats
- Mobility needs – accessible classrooms, assistive devices
- Blind or low vision – screen readers, audio materials, exam support
- Speech-language impairments – alternative participation formats
- Deaf or hard of hearing – captioning, interpreters, transcription



PU offers a support scheme for students and employees living with disabilities, giving access to essential rehabilitation and assistive services – made possible through our partnership with LWAH. Each case is reviewed individually to determine the right level of support.

SUPPORT SERVICES

- Prosthetic and orthotic services
- Hearing aids
- Physical therapy, including a gym equipped for rehabilitation
- Mobility and daily-living aids (wheelchairs, walkers, and more)
- Speech and occupational therapy



Getting Started

During the application process, you'll be asked: "Do you have any accessibility or medical needs that may require support during your studies?" From there, the Student Health Care Center reaches out to understand your specific needs, gather any relevant documentation, and begin setting up the right accommodations well before your first day of classes. We welcome you to visit our campus, meet our support team, and see firsthand how PU makes every student's journey accessible.
